The **Niseko HANAZONO Hill climb** is mass start bicycle road race, starting from the centre of Kutchan town & finishing at Go-shiki Onsen.

The race climbs 617 vertical metres over 15.5 km at an average grade of 4.6%. The hill climb will be run in conjunction with the Kutchan Jagata-matsuri. There are a number of categories ranging from elite to beginners and the focus of the event is on participation.
